



# SETTING GOALS FOR YOUR KINGDOM VISION

# WAITING ON GOD FOR CLARITY OF PURPOSE

## 1. Waiting on God for Clarity of Purpose

Before setting goals, it's important to seek God and allow Him to reveal His purpose.

- **Pray & Seek God's Will** – (Psalm 32:8) Ask God to reveal His assignment for you.
- **Be Still & Listen** – (Psalm 46:10) Set aside quiet time to hear from God.
- **Look for Confirmation** – (Proverbs 19:21) Pay attention to repeated themes in scripture, sermons, or wise counsel.
- **Assess Your Burdens & Passions** – What needs, people, or causes weigh on your hearts? Often, God places desires within us for a reason.



**Journaling Prompt:** "Lord, what have You assigned me to do in this season? Where do You want me to make an impact?"

# WRITING THE VISION AND MAKING IT CLEAR

## 2. Writing the Vision & Making It Clear

Once you have a sense of your assignment, define your vision.

- **Write It Down** – (Habakkuk 2:2) Clarity comes when we put it into words.
- **Identify the 'Why'** – (Colossians 3:23) Why does this vision matter for God's kingdom?
- **Define the Impact** – Who will benefit from this vision? How will it glorify God?



**Vision Board/Journal Activity:** Write Your vision statement or create a vision board with scriptures, images, or words that reflect your assignment.

# SETTING GODLY GOALS

## 3. Setting Godly Goals

Goals should align with God's purpose and be realistic yet faith-driven.

- **Set Faith-Based Goals** – (Ephesians 2:10) What steps will help fulfill this assignment?
- **Break It Down** – What short-term and long-term steps are needed?
- **Make It Measurable** – How will you track progress? Example: "I will disciple one person this year" vs. "I want to disciple people."



**Journal Prompt:** "What small steps can I take this month toward my God-given vision?"

# OVERCOMING CHALLENGES & STAYING FOCUSED

## 4. Overcoming Challenges & Staying Focused

- **Expect Opposition** – (Nehemiah 6:3) Stay committed even when distractions arise.
- **Trust God's Timing** – (Ecclesiastes 3:1) Not everything happens at once.
- **Stay in Prayer & the Word** – (Joshua 1:8) Regular scripture reading will keep you aligned with God's plan.
- **Find Accountability** – Have a mentor or prayer partner for encouragement.



**Reflection:** "What obstacles might come up, and how can I stay focused on God's plan?"

# REVIEWING & ADJUSTING THE VISION

## 5. Reviewing & Adjusting the Vision

- **Check Progress Regularly** – (Lamentations 3:40) Reflect on what's working.
- **Celebrate Small Wins** – Give thanks for each step forward.
- **Be Willing to Adjust** – If God redirects, be open to change.



**Closing Activity:** Set a reminder (weekly or monthly) to revisit your vision board or journal, pray over your goals, and realign with God.
